# FALL 2025 CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY



## Participant Code (Initial):

# I WILL:

- Emphasize the ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play.
- Show courtesy to my opponents and officials.
- Recognize athletic contests are serious educational endeavors.
- Give complete allegiance to my coaches who are the instructional authority for my team.
- Discourage fans, fellow teammates, and parents from undercutting my coach's authority.

# I WILL NOT:

- Use profanity or talk "trash" before, during, or after any game.
- Use drugs, alcohol, or tobacco. Criticize my teammates.
- Act in any way that may incite spectators.
- Use social media to bully or trash talk any coach, team or player.

## Parent/Guardian Code (Initial):

#### I WILL:

- Support my child's team/squad and teach the value of commitment to the team/ squad – emphasis the ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct & fair play.
- Help my child and WVYFC make athletic contests a positive educational experience.
- Show courtesy to opponents & officials.
- Direct constructive criticism of my child's athletic program to the athletic director of association officials and work towards a positive result for all concerned.

#### LWILL NOT:

- Criticize participants of the league (including but not limited to officials, league, participants, coaches, opponents, volunteers, my child, etc.) direct abuse or profane language toward them, or otherwise subvert their authority.
- Undermine, in word or deed, the authority of the coach or administration.
- Intrude onto the field, stand on the sideline or yell from the bleachers to the coaches, referees, or administration.
- Use social media to bully or trash talk any coach, team or player.

# Volunteer/Coach Code (Initial):

#### I WILL:

- Respect the integrity and judgment of contest officials/judges and work with them to promote positive experiences.
- Establish and model fair play, sportsmanship, and proper conduct.
- Hold in highest priority the establishment of the child's safety and welfare.
- Provide proper supervision of all the athletes at all times.
- Use discretion when providing constructive criticism and when reprimanding an athlete. Maintain consistency in requiring athletes to adhere to established rules and standards of the contest played.
- Follow the WVYFC rules of behavior and the procedures for responsible crowd control.
- Vigorously encourage and support athletes.

# I WILL NOT:

- Suggest, provide, or encourage athletes to use non-prescription drugs or substances.
- Promote acts that will in any way incite spectators in a negative manner.
- Use social media to bully or trash talk any coach, team, player or parent.

#### **ARTIFICIAL TURF REGULATIONS**

- Site & Facility Clean-Up: The applicant is responsible for set-up, clean-up and any damages to the facilities resulting in use of the facility. Clean-up includes, but is not limited to picking up litter, dumping garbage cans, cleaning up food & beverage spills.
- Clean-up area includes but is not limited to playing fields, sidelines & parking areas.
- No Alcoholic Beverages: No alcohol is allowed on City of Eugene, City of Springfield or Eugene or Springfield School District property.
- No Glass Containers: Beverage containers made of glass are not allowed.
- Parking: Parking is restricted to designated areas only.
- Supervision: The applicant is responsible for supervision of the facilities being used during the time he or she is scheduled to use
  the facility.
- No Tobacco Products: Use of cigarettes, electronic cigarettes, cigars and pipes or the oral use of tobacco products is strictly prohibited.
- No Dogs: Dogs are not allowed inside stadium gates.
- Food: No sunflower seeds, gum or peanut shells are allowed on the artificial turf fields.
- Cleats: Cleats are permitted, but players may not use cleats that have any metal exposed.
- PA Systems: Setting up or using a public address system without written permission from the City of Eugene or Springfield is prohibited.
- Canopies & Other Equipment: Setting up or constructing any temporary structures including but not limited to canopies, chairs, and tents without permission from the City of Eugene or Springfield is prohibited.

All On Site Facilities reserve the right to monitor the event at any time for compliance with the regulations, policies and terms of this application. Failure to comply with the regulations, policies, and terms of this application may cause the group to lose the right to use the facility.















A spectator, participant, or Coach/Team Manager in violation of the Code of Conduct or Artificial Turf Policy may result in the minimum suspension of one game up to the remainder of the season, this will be at the discretion of the Head Coach, Area Representative, or League Sportsmanship Committee. Every PARTICIPANT, PARENT, & COACH MUST SIGN this form. By signing, he/she is assuring WVYFC that you have reviewed and agree with the Code of Conduct and Artificial Turf Policies.
